Partner Updates	Gina Firth reported all was quiet at UT (summer break). Dr. Vani Simmons reported that Moffitt was utilizing Sunclair, a TFPH member for brief commercials regarding tobacco and that the grant funding "Project Quit" is in full swing. Gina Stiles reported that Baycare will be smokefree by January 3, 2011! Sigrid Tidmore reported on the success of Healthy Together's African American Health initiative. She also reported on and demonstrated a clever mobile stop smoking texting program and plans implementation of the program in November. Terri Arias reported that Hillsborough County is on hold with their tobacco free initiatives until the current interim County Administrator (Mike Merrill) is ready to pursue. Helen Justice reported that DUI Counterattack is working with TFPH to implement Breathe Easy Zones. Dotti Groover-Skipper reported on the successes of the TFPH presentation to the Hillsborough County Medical Association's Executive Council. Over 1500 physicians' were reached with 5 A's, 5 R's and Quitline fax referral info. She also reported on assisting DUI Counterattack and Traffic Control Products with tobacco policy.	Moffitt's "Project Quit" is currently recruiting smokers. TFPH will support Baycare, as it can, toward becoming smokefree. Sigrid Tidmore will assist at the TFPH table for TGH event June 30. DUI Counterattack is implementing Breathe Easy Zones 8/10 TFPH logo is placed on the HCMA website, as well as Quitline information, and Community Tobacco Resources. TFPH was invited to write an article for the HCMA newsletter publication.
Youth	Laurie reported on SWAT successes and on Dr. Victor DeNoble presentations to 3 Hillsborough County schools. She also reported on the "STOMP IT OUT" winners on Channel 10.
